


# INTERPRETING LIMB X-RAYS: A BRIEF GUIDE

### ACCURATE

Is this the right patient?
Is it the right image?
Is it the correct view?
Is the image adequate?





#### RONES

Review each bone; are there any irregularities or fractures?





#### CORTEX

Is there any cortical or articular surface involvement





### DISLOCATIONS

Are there any dislocations or subluxations? Is there any angulation?





## EVERYTHING ELSE

Soft tissues? Foreign bodies etc.
